

The Group expands its commercial presence in West Africa with a new agency in Mali



With the opening of a new agency at Bamako in Mali, the Group continues to expand its activities in West Africa (two agencies in Liberia and Burkina Faso opened at the start of 2012 and two others are soon to be inaugurated in Sierra Leone and Gambia). Managed by Gorel Patrick Samatey, General Manager, this new office will have eight staff members.

With the development of its intermodal network, the Group is in a position to offer an extended inland coverage via rail and road links to support economic expansion in land-locked countries. Mali is served via Dakar (Hebdo and Ro-Ro Atlantic services from North Europe, Ro-Ro Med Africa and Diams from the Mediterranean and the Battuta Express) and via Abidjan (same services plus MIDAS from India and the Arabian Gulf and WAX from Asia).
